



## Gilded cage

Definition: place or situation which is attractive but constraining (Wiktionary)

Nightingale recalled living in the "gilded cage" of her privileged childhood, the "luxurious prison" in which she determined that she would become a nurse.

Around the same time (1835), three Japanese sailors visited London after drifting away for one year in the Pacific Ocean.

One of them, Otokichi became a British citizen and changed his name to John Matthew Ottoson.

"News of captives eventually reached John McLoughlin (1784-1857), chief factor of Fort Vancouver, then the headquarters of the Hudson's Bay Company's vast Columbia Department. ... Written alongside were what McLoughlin concluded were "Chinese characters," leading him to assume the sailors were Chinese. ... Perhaps the strangest aspect of life at the fort for the three castaways was its polyracial, polyglot nature. Fort Vancouver in the 1830s was the most racially and ethnically diverse enclave on the West Coast."
